Code of Conduct:

To ensure the collective quality and efficiency of our athletic training and mentoring program we stand firmly behind these policies and code of conduct. Any violation of these policies will be subject to warning and review. Further violations will lead to disqualification from Purpose Field. Purpose Field reserves the right to discontinue membership upon any violation.

Purpose Field athletes will not be the party or a party to bullying (online/offline), fighting (during gameplay included), theft (or related criminal activity), cheating, illegal drug use, alcoholic consumption, or any other activity deemed as illicit.

Purpose Field athletes will strive to maintain an exemplary academic record (3.0 GPA minimum) and efficiently return results when subjected to grade checks.

Purpose Field athletes will uphold a high standard within the classroom in terms of behavior and attendance will be counted on as leaders on their campuses and fields of play.

Purpose Field athletes will be respectful and honorable toward each gender, religion, ethnicity, political affiliation, and sexual preference.

Purpose Field athletes will be respectful and honorable toward their parents and other levels of authority.

Purpose Field athletes will be respectful and honorable toward all coaches and staff.

Purpose Field athletes will represent themselves with class and dignity within their social media presence.

Purpose Field athletes will refrain from hurtful language, slurs, and obscenities.

Attendance Policies & Expectations:

Purpose Field athletes will maintain a consistent standing in terms of their practice attendance.

Purpose Field athletes will arrive to practice in a timely fashion (15–20 minutes early). One warning on the first violation, discipline on the second violation.

Purpose Field athletes will arrive at tournaments a minimum of 1.5 hrs before gametime. One warning on the first violation, discipline on the second violation.

In the case of sickness, personal engagements, vacation, other sport gamedays, or the related occurrences FieldUP athletes must personally notify Coach Paige 24 hours in advance.

Texts or calls hours and/or minutes before practice time will not be accepted. 'No-call, no show' violations will not be accepted.

Players will be truthful in their communication with Coach Paige.

One warning on the first violation, discipline on the second violation.

*Any violation of the listed policies and conditions above by the athlete or parent will lead to disciplinary action which includes suspension/loss of opportunity and ultimately dismissal from the team.
